42nd Annual Parade – Participant Rules & Information

Thanks to everyone who participated in last year's parade, it became the largest the Lake has ever seen, with an estimated **25,000+ spectators**. This year, our goal is to make the parade **bigger, better, and safer**. Due to increased crowd movement toward the center of the road and several close calls along the route last year, safety **must** be a top priority for all participants. To ensure a safe and successful event for participants, spectators, volunteers, and emergency personnel, all participants must follow the guidelines below.

CHECK-IN

- At least **one representative per group** must check in the day of the parade
- Parking lot at **Kohl's in Eagle's Landing Shopping Center**
- **9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.**
- Roads close to through traffic at **12:30 p.m.**

LINEUP

- Lineup is **first come, first serve**. However, a few entries will have a designated spot
- Multiple vehicles **must arrive together** to be placed together
- Parade begins at **Tomahawk Motel / Brandon Michael Building**
- Parade start time: **1:00 p.m.**
-  Lineup tags must be obtained (at check-in) and displayed during parade

JUDGING

- Judging occurs at **Lake Realty (left side of route)**
- Participants are encouraged to decorate in **St. Patrick's Day spirit**
- Winners announced Monday on **MIX 92.7** and the **MIX 92.7 Facebook page**

PARADE MOVEMENT RULES

- It is **HIGHLY** advised that you have someone walk alongside to pass out candy. However, you may throw candy, but **PLEASE** throw candy to the edge of the road.
- Please **DO NOT** stop on the parade route. Keep up with the participant in front of you.
- **NO alcohol** may be consumed on floats or vehicles or passed to spectators

MODOT REQUIREMENTS

- **18,000-lb. weight limit** across Bagnell Dam
- All floats and vehicles must comply
- Parade officials reserve the right to deny participation for safety concerns



END-OF-PARADE PROCEDURES

When approaching the dam, choose **one option**:

Option 1:

Cross the dam → **Mt. Carmel Baptist Church parking lot** → remove decorations and depart

Option 2:

Turn onto **Valley Road** → **Heritage Elementary parking lot** → remove decorations and wait until parade clears School Road to leave.

If you need to load walkers back onto floats, pull to the **left near Celebration Cruises** to avoid backing up the parade and load them and move on.

⊘ DO NOT STOP OR WAIT IN THE PARADE ROUTE ON THE STRIP NEAR THE DAM

VOLUNTEERS & LAW ENFORCEMENT

All participants **MUST** follow instructions from **Parade Volunteers** and **Lake Ozark and Camden/Miller County law enforcement**. Their directions are final and given for everyone's safety.

Failure to comply — including disagreeing with or cursing at volunteers — will result in **disqualification from future parades**.
